Southern Wesleyan University Policies and Procedures

Special Student Status

"Special Students" wishing to utilize F.A. must submit a schedule listing at least 21 credit hours they plan to take. This must be done before a student can start classes as a F.A. student.

Drop-in Classes

Financial Aid students will be required to pay for classes taken outside of the core program. Students may use Financial Aid funds to pay for these classes only if there is an available balance on hand at the time the cost is incurred.

Withdrawal/Refund Policy

Any student who withdraws from the program (permanently or temporarily) **will be** subject to Federal Regulations regarding the refund of student loans and grants. To receive full Financial Aid, a student must complete at least 24 credit hours in a one-year time frame and not be out of attendance, at any time, for more than 29 days.

Drug Abuse Prevention

STUDENT ACKNOWLEDGMENT

In applying for financial aid while attending Southern Wesleyan University, the student acknowledges the following:

- 1. Applying for financial aid does not remove responsibility for payment. If funding is not received, the student must pay all outstanding balances immediately.
- 2. An insurance premium and a loan origination fee may be deducted by the lender from the student's loan proceeds prior to disbursement. This amount is estimated to be around 2.5%.
- 3. Withdrawal from the program, no matter what the reason, **will affect** the amount of aid a student can receive. Eligibility is based on the number of credit hours and the number of weeks of instructional time completed.
- 4. The college can only certify eligibility to apply for a student loan. Final determination of loan eligibility is made by the lender and the government guarantee agency.
- 5. Loan periods are divided into two payment periods. Therefore, checks are released at the beginning and midpoint of the award period. Credits for the first half must be completed before the second half funds can be released. In addition, students are not eligible to apply for a second loan until course credit obligations for the first loan are close to completion.
- 6. Financial aid is processed on a twelve-month basis. **Students must reapply every year.** If the student's loan start date falls between April 1st and June 30th, two application packets must be completed, one for the prior financial aid year and one for the upcoming financial aid year.
- 7. The student must be actively in attendance to receive financial aid money. Therefore, aid will not be disbursed between courses or programs.
