SWU students must receive pre-approval to take CLEP exams by completing the “CLEP / DSST Permission” form downloaded from the SWU website, obtained from the roto-rack at the local learning center, or from their academic advisor. Students must make their own arrangements to test at a CLEP testing center and attain the minimum credit granting scores (no exceptions are made) to earn the credits and course equivalencies listed below.
