Locating Children's Books by Subject in \$WUcat

Children's books have subject headings, just like other books in the catalog. To locate a children's book on a particular subject, enter "subject--Juvenile literature" (for non-fiction) or "subject--Juvenile fiction" (for fiction). For example:

Insects--Juvenile literature *or*

Bashfulness--Juvenile fiction

Of course, books may also be located by conducting an author or title search, if the information is known.

Locating Teaching Resources

The library collection has many resources to help teachers develop ideas for teaching reading and literacy. When searching \$WUcat, try the following subject headings:

Children--Books and reading

First year teachers--Handbooks, manuals, etc.

Language arts (Early Childhood) *or* Language arts (Elementary), etc.

Literacy--Study and teaching

Picture books for children--Educational aspects

Reading *or* Reading--remedial teaching
