## **HELP! I NEED TO FIND THE....**

#### **SCORE**

#### **FIRST LOOK IN:**

<u>SWUcat</u> (the library catalog)

#### THEN TRY:

- PASCALCAT (the SC statewide catalog—items arrive in about 3 days)
- Worldcat.org (worldwide catalog...look for an item, then use our interlibrary loan service which is FREE TO YOU as a SWU student to get it)

#### **ALSO USE:**

- CPDL.org (choral music)
- IMSLP.org (free scores of music in the public domain, i.e. not copyrighted)

#### **ENGLISH TRANSLATION**

#### **OPERA**

- The Aria Database: http://www.aria-database.com
- Find a score of the work using one of the sources above it often will have the English translation
  - NOTE: it may rhyme & not be literal. Dr. Rowell wants you to find the <u>literal</u> translation.

#### **OTHER**

- Websites/Online Translators
  - NOTE: Translations of songs on the web, especially ones the RHYME perfectly, may be entirely incorrect translations of your song. You need to find the <u>literal translation</u>.
  - NOTE: Online translators are often only 80% correct, and Dr. Rowell will know if it is wrong!
- Foreign language dictionaries are in the REFERENCE SECTION in the 400s

#### **IPA TRANSCRIPTION**

#### **FIRST**

- Go to <u>SWUcat</u> and type in "international phonetic alphabet" into the first box. (NOT just "IPA")
  - The results will show all of the books that will give you the entire IPA translation of your work—mostly applicable to classical works/art song
  - Nearly all of these books are located in the 782.42 section on the second floor

#### **THEN**

- IPA Manual REF 783.0014 W154 (REFERENCE SECTION)
- Your diction book

#### **ALSO**

- Visit Furman's campus and use IPA Source, a databases with thousands of IPA translations of art songs and arias.
  - O NOTE: Good for classical works, not so good for popular works!
- Google your song title and "IPA"...sometimes you can get really lucky and find it!
